Subject: New Enhancements in NSDL SPEED-e Mobile App

Participants are familiar with the range of features offered by NSDL SPEED-e Mobile App for clients. These include viewing of demat account holdings with their values, participating in e-Voting, confirming margin pledge initiation and Off-Market Instruction (secured by OTP), managing nomination preferences (opt-in/opt-out), nominating online, etc. Moreover, clients with authorization from

Participants can submit electronic delivery and mutual fund redemption instructions.

New enhancements in NSDL SPEED-e Mobile App

1. Client Master Report (CMR):

NSDL SPEED-e Mobile App now enables clients to conveniently download digitally signed

Client Master Report online.

2. Download of NSDL e-CAS:

NSDL SPEED-e Mobile App now offers a seamless way for clients to access their NSDL Consolidated Account Statement (NSDL e-CAS) for the past twelve months. This service simplifies the retrieval process and enhances client convenience. Participants are encouraged

to inform their clients about the expected timing of receiving the NSDL e-CAS, as outlined below:

(a) Monthly Dispatch: Clients (except BSDA clients) who have conducted any transactions in their demat account or mutual fund folio during the month will receive the NSDL e-

CAS.

(b) Quarterly Dispatch (March, June, September, and December end): BSDA clients with transactions in their demat account or mutual fund folio during the quarter will receive

the NSDL e-CAS.

(c) Half Yearly Dispatch (September end and March end): Clients without transactions but

with balances in their demat account or mutual fund folios will receive the NSDL e-CAS.

(d) Yearly Dispatch (March end): Clients with no transactions or balances in their demat

account or mutual fund folios will receive the NSDL e-CAS.



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3. Enhanced e-Voting:

The e-Voting feature has been enhanced to enable all demat account holders to conveniently cast their votes through the NSDL SPEED-e Mobile App, regardless of the e-Voting Services Provider (ESP) chosen by the Issuer. Clients can now access the e-Voting pages of different ESPs directly via the NSDL SPEED-e Mobile App using a single sign-on (SSO) process. This enhancement, which was previously available on IDeAS Web, has now been seamlessly integrated into the NSDL SPEED-e App.
