#### **Bullion**

Gold settled lower as fairly strong stock markets and a steady dollar amid continued optimism about economic recovery dimmed the demand for the safe-haven commodity. Philadelphia Fed Bank President Patrick Harker said Fed officials should start talking about the best way to reduce their asset purchases "sooner rather than later."

#### Energy

Crude oil prices rose sharply after a report from the U.S. National Hurricane Centre that a storm forming over the Western Gulf of Mexico will likely become a cyclone over the weekend raised concerns about possible disruptions in production. Natural gas eased as production continued to edge higher and exports slip.

#### Base Metal

Copper fell weighed down by fears that authorities in top consumer China will take measures to curb a rally in commodity prices. China said it would strengthen its management of commodity supply and demand to curb "unreasonable" increases in prices and prevent them being passed on to consumers.
