Bullion

Gold prices eased hurt by an uptick in the U.S. dollar and bond yields, while investors awaited key economic readings out of the United States. Fed vice chair Richard Clarida said the U.S. central bank can curb an outbreak of inflation should it occur without throwing recovery off track.

Energy

Crude oil prices remained under pressure amid worries that a possible return of Iranian supply could cause a glut. Natural gas rose on expectations that surging global prices will boost U.S. exports back to record highs in coming weeks.

Base Metal

Copper prices gained as a planned labour strike at the world's biggest copper mine in Chile threatened already low global supplies of the metal. Refined copper output in top consumer China could increase 6% year-on-year to 9.86 million tonnes in 2021, while demand is likely to grow 3.3% over the same period.
