**Taking global cues, the Nifty is expected to open positive around 16,200 and likely to remain range-bound in the price band of 15,950-16,300.**

The Nifty previous session ended 1.55% up at 16,130.75. It opened on a positive note above the 15,900 mark and continued moving higher towards settling off around the second resistance placed around 16,120 levels. Chart pattern suggests the benchmark index moving further higher towards 16,300 is quite likely. Midway resistance is placed around 16,200. Intraday retracement may find support around 15,950 levels. Probable broader trading range is likely to be 15,950-16,300.

On the Nifty hourly chart, sharply rising RSI coupled with ADX trending higher suggests the Benchmark Index may continue trading on a positive note. Immediate resistance is placed around 16,200 levels.

Nifty patterns on multiple periods suggest; ending the day with a Bullish candle above 15,900 mark is a positive development, which might be helpful in taking the benchmark index further higher towards 16,300 levels. Buy on dips is advised.

The Bank Nifty previous session ended 1.43% up at 35,207.45. It might get into the trading range of 35,100-35,800.

### **Asian Stocks Steady as Virus, China Spur Caution**

Asian stocks were steady Wednesday as China's clampdown on its technology giants and the spread of the delta Covid-19 strain restrained sentiment. Shares rose in China and Hong Kong, but slipped in Japan, where SoftBank Group Corp. retreated on a potential block of its \$40 billion sale of Arm Ltd. to chip company Nvidia Corp. U.S. equity contracts posted modest losses. Company earnings took the S&P 500 to another all-time high overnight. Traders are monitoring fears that online gaming may be the next industry in the firing line of Beijing's sweeping regulatory crackdown on technology giants. Alibaba Group Holding Ltd.'s revenue missed estimates for the first time in over two years, a sign of the clampdown's toll. The 10-year U.S. Treasury yield held its retreat and oil weakened toward \$70 a barrel. The delta strain is exacerbating concerns that the rebound from the pandemic is losing steam. New Zealand jobs data strengthened rate-hike bets, bolstering its currency but weighing on the 10-year bond.

### **Trump's Endorsed Candidate Wins Republican Primary in Ohio**

A candidate endorsed by Donald Trump won a special Republican primary race for a U.S. House seat in Ohio on Tuesday, bolstering the former president's efforts to steer election outcomes heading into the 2022 congressional races. Coal industry consultant and lobbyist Mike Carey defeated 10 other candidates in a crowded GOP primary to replace former Representative Steve Stivers, who resigned in May to lead the Ohio Chamber of Commerce, according to results from The Associated Press. Carey will now face state Representative Allison Russo, who easily won the Democratic primary, in the Nov. 2 special general election to fill the seat. Democrats were also holding a special primary election in another part of the state to replace Marcia Fudge, now Department of Housing and Urban Development secretary, that became a proxy fight between the party's progressive and centrist wings over support for President Joe Biden.

### **Oil Drops for Third Day as China Battles to Quash Delta Outbreak**

Oil dropped for a third straight day on concern that curbs to combat the spread of the delta coronavirus variant will hurt demand, with investors zeroing in on a fast-spreading outbreak in key importer China. West Texas Intermediate sank toward \$70 a barrel after retreating 4.6% over the first two days of the week. The variant has been detected in nearly half of China's 32 provinces within just two weeks. At least 46 cities have advised residents not to travel unless it's absolutely necessary.

### **F.D.A. Aims to Give Final Approval to Pfizer Vaccine by Early Next Month**

The Food and Drug Administration's move is expected to kick off more vaccination mandates for hospital workers, college students and federal troops. With a new surge of Covid-19 infections ripping through much of the United States, the Food and Drug Administration has accelerated its timetable to fully approve Pfizer-BioNTech's coronavirus vaccine, aiming to complete the process by the start of next month, people involved in the effort said. President Biden said last week that he expected a fully approved vaccine in early fall. But the F.D.A.'s unofficial deadline is Labor Day or sooner, according to multiple people familiar with the plan. The agency said in a statement that its leaders recognized that approval might inspire more public confidence and had "taken an all-hands-on-deck approach" to the work. Giving final approval to the Pfizer vaccine rather than relying on the emergency authorization granted late last year by the F.D.A. could help increase inoculation rates at a moment when the highly transmissible Delta variant of the virus is sharply driving up the number of new cases.

### Delta Spikes Herd Immunity Threshold to Over 80%

The spread of the delta coronavirus variant has pushed the threshold for herd immunity to well over 80% and potentially almost 90%, the Infectious Diseases Society of America said. U.S. President Joe Biden criticized the pandemic response of the Florida and Texas governors, both Republicans. The two states account for about a third of all new U.S. cases in the past week. Thailand had record deaths and cases, while Australia found a case in the far-north city of Cairns. Hong Kong imposed a quarantine on arrivals from Macau and there's growing concern about a resurgence of the virus in mainland China, which has renewed many curbs and is discouraging unnecessary travel.
