Bullion

Gold skidded as robust U.S. jobs data stoked fears that the Federal Reserve would raises rates quicker than expected, increasing the opportunity cost of holding non-interest bearing bullion. U.S. employers hired the most workers in nearly a year in July and continued to raise wages, giving the economy a powerful boost.

Energy

Crude oil dropped on the back of a rising U.S. dollar and concerns that new coronavirus-related restrictions in Asia, especially China, could slow a global recovery in fuel demand. Natural gas slipped due to a drop in oil prices despite mostly steady forecasts for hotter-than-normal weather to continue over the next two weeks.

Base Metal

Copper prices dropped as concerns linger over the slowdown in economic recovery due to the delta variant. China's central bank said it would keep prudent monetary policy flexible and appropriate while prioritising stability.
